There are 1,952 places to buy alcohol in Edinburgh:

1,467 on-sales premises (pubs and restaurants)





485 off-sales premises (supermarkets and shops)

Scottish Liquor Licensing Statistics 2021-22.

In Edinburgh, 28% of people drink above the Chief Medical Officers' low-risk guidelines.

This includes 21% of women and 36% of men.

This compares to 20% of people in Scotland who drink above the guidelines.

Parental drinking was a concern identified for 19% of children on the child protection register in Edinburgh.

Children's Social Work Statistics 2022-23.

38% of S2 and S4 students in Edinburgh drink alcohol.

16% of S2 and S4 students in Edinburgh drink alcohol at least once a month.

There were 2,040 alcohol-related hospital admissions in Edinburgh in 2022-23.

The admission rate was lower than for Scotland as a whole.

In Edinburgh, 89 people died because of alcohol in 2023, from conditions solely caused by alcohol.

Alcohol-specific deaths 2023.

The death rate was lower than Scotland as a whole.

The true number of alcohol deaths is over twice as high when including conditions such as cancer and cardiovascular diseases.

Every year, alcohol costs Edinburgh £221.28m or £455 per person.
