Scottish Liquor Licensing Statistics 2021-22.

In Inverciyde, 27% of people drink above the Chief Medical Officers' low-risk guidelines.

This includes 18% of women and 37% of men.

This compares to 20% of people in Scotland who drink above the guidelines.

Parental drinking was a concern identified for 11% of children on the child protection register in Inverclyde.

Children's Social Work Statistics 2022-23.

32% of 13-year-olds and 64% of 15-year-olds in Inverciyde have drunk alcohol.

Of those who have ever drunk alcohol, 71% of 13-year-olds and 77% of 15-year-olds have been drunk.

Scottish Schools Adolescent Lifestyle and Substance Use Survey 2018.

There were 618 alcohol-related hospital admissions in Inverciyde in 2022-23.

The admission rate was higher than for Scotland as a whole.

In Inverciyde, 33 people died because of alcohol in 2023, from conditions solely caused by alcohol.

Alcohol-specific deaths 2023.

The death rate was higher than for Scotland as a whole.

The true number of alcohol deaths is over twice as high when including conditions such as cancer and cardiovascular diseases.

Public Health Scotland.

Every year, alcohol costs Inverciyde £35.40m or £444 per person.
