(pubs and restaurants)

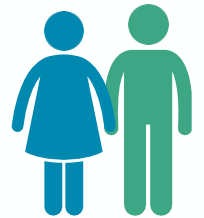


104 off-sales premises

Scottish Liquor Licensing Statistics 2021-22.

In Moray, **20% of people** drink above the Chief Medical Officers' low-risk guidelines.

This includes **15% of women** and **26% of men**.



This compares to **20% of people** in Scotland who drink above the guidelines.

Scottish Health Survey.



Parental drinking was a concern identified for **23% of children** on the child protection register in Moray.

Children's Social Work Statistics 2022-23.

57% of S2 and S4 students in Moray drink alcohol.

27% of S2 and S4 students in Moray drink alcohol at least once a month.



Health and Wellbeing Census Scotland 2021-2022.

There were **339 alcohol-related hospital admissions** in Moray in 2022-23.

Alcohol related hospital statistics 2022-23.

The admission rate was lower than for Scotland as a whole.

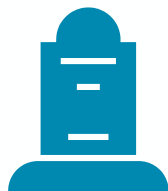


In Moray, **19 people** died because of alcohol in 2023, from conditions solely caused by alcohol.

The death rate was lower than Scotland as a whole.

The **true number** of alcohol deaths is **over twice as high** when including conditions such as cancer and cardiovascular diseases.

Public Health Scotland.

Every year, alcohol costs Moray **£33.31m or £380 per person**.

This includes:

Health Service	£2.83m
Social Care	£4.43m
Crime	£14.60m
Productive Capacity	£11.46m
