There are 715 places to buy alcohol in North Lanarkshire:

394 on-sales premises (pubs and restaurants)





321 off-sales premises (supermarkets and shops)

In North Lanarkshire, 20% of people drink above the Chief Medical Officers' low-risk auidelines.

This includes 12% of women and 30% of men.

This compares to 20% of people in Scotland who drink above the auidelines.





Parental drinking was a concern identified for 24% of children on the child protection register in North Lanarkshire.

Children's Social Work Statistics 2022-23.

32% of 13-year-olds and 70% of 15-year-olds in North Lanarkshire have drunk alcohol.


Of those who have ever drunk alcohol, 59% of 13-year-olds and 75% of 15-year-olds have been drunk.

There were 2,391 alcohol-related hospital admissions in North Lanarkshire in 2022-23.

Alcohol related hospital statistics 2022-23.


The admission rate was higher than for Scotland as a whole.

In North Lanarkshire, 115 people died because of alcohol in 2023, from conditions solely caused by alcohol.
