(pubs and restaurants)

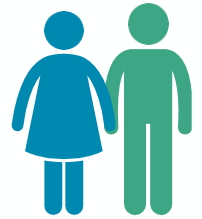


152 off-sales premises

Scottish Liquor Licensing Statistics 2021-22.

In Renfrewshire, **19% of people** drink above the Chief Medical Officers' low-risk guidelines.

This includes **12% of women** and **27% of men**.



This compares to **20% of people** in Scotland who drink above the guidelines.

Parental drinking was a concern identified for **25% of children** on the child protection register in Renfrewshire.

Children's Social Work Statistics 2022-23.

There were **1,113 alcohol-related hospital admissions** in Renfrewshire in 2022-23.

The admission rate was higher than for Scotland as a whole.

In Renfrewshire, **52 people** died because of alcohol in 2023, from conditions solely caused by alcohol.

The death rate was higher than Scotland as a whole.

The **true number** of alcohol deaths is **over twice as high** when including conditions such as cancer and cardiovascular diseases.

Public Health Scotland.

42% of S2 and S4 students in Renfrewshire drink alcohol.

20% of S2 and S4 students in Renfrewshire drink alcohol at least once a month.

Every year, alcohol costs Renfrewshire **£72.23m or £424 per person**.

This includes:

Health Service	£10.97m
Social Care	£9.93m
Crime	£27.23m
Productive Capacity	£24.11m
